Subject: Closure of Lincoln Ave. Bridge

The Tacoma Public Works Department will rehabilitate the Lincoln Avenue Bridge starting in May of this year. This work will require closure of the bridge for 7 months up to one year depending on weather. This closure will impact the heavy haul route across the Puyallup River.

During the bridge closure a temporary heavy haul route will be in place for your use. The route will use Puyallup Avenue, Pacific Avenue, and SR 509 to cross the Puyallup River. A map is included on the reverse side of this sheet that outlines the route. All existing heavy haul routes will remain in place except the Lincoln Ave. Bridge. This temporary route will be removed once the bridge project is complete.

You will still need to obtain the proper permits from the City of Tacoma and from the State of Washington.
