

WTA/DAVE WELDY SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM ACADEMIC APPLICATION

Since the inception of this program, over 200 scholarships totaling more than \$100,000 have been distributed to deserving applicants. Annual grants of \$250 to \$2000 for academic and vocational scholarships will be awarded by the Washington Trucking Associations to eligible students who are related to an employee of a current WTA member. The scholarship fund is sponsored by the Suppliers Conference of the Association. All proceeds from the Roger Mauch Memorial Golf Tournament and the WTA Eastside Golf Classic are donated to this scholarship fund.

Scholarship Eligibility: Must be a graduate or graduating senior of a Washington State high school, who is currently a Washington State resident and is the child, grandchild, niece or nephew of an employee of a current WTA member in good standing.

Selection Criteria: Must include the applicant's academic achievements, education and career goals, demonstration of leadership, level of financial need (please describe in the essay portion of the application), performance of community service and employment record.

Applicants may submit an application for either an Academic Scholarship or a Vocational Scholarship (depending on their educational goals), but not both. All applications must be received at the WTA office no later than **June 30, 2010.**

The scholarship review board will review the applications in July, and recipients will be announced on or around August 1, 2010. Recipients of Merit Scholarship Awards may use funds to attend accredited colleges or universities, community colleges, or vocational institutions.

Academic Scholarship applicants must submit:

- Academic Application, which must be fully completed and attached as the first page of the application package. **(BE SURE TO LIST YOUR SPONSOR AND THEIR RELATIONSHIP TO YOU.)**
- Certified high school transcript from ninth grade to date of application.
- An essay, not exceeding 300 words, summarizing:
 - School and extracurricular activities and accomplishments
 - The applicant's objectives and goals for higher education
 - Financial need
 - Reasons the applicant believes he/she qualifies for the scholarship award
- Letter of endorsement from one community leader, not related to the applicant, who has had the opportunity to personally observe the applicant's character, industry and purposefulness.
- Renewal applicants must have proof of and maintain a minimum GPA of 3.00 to be eligible; however, it is not a guarantee that you will be selected as a scholarship recipient.

Renewal applicants must submit an application, essay (as described above), and college transcript.
